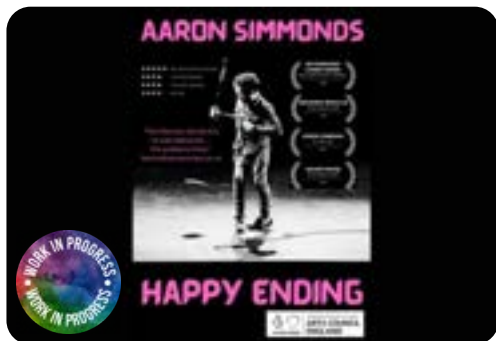

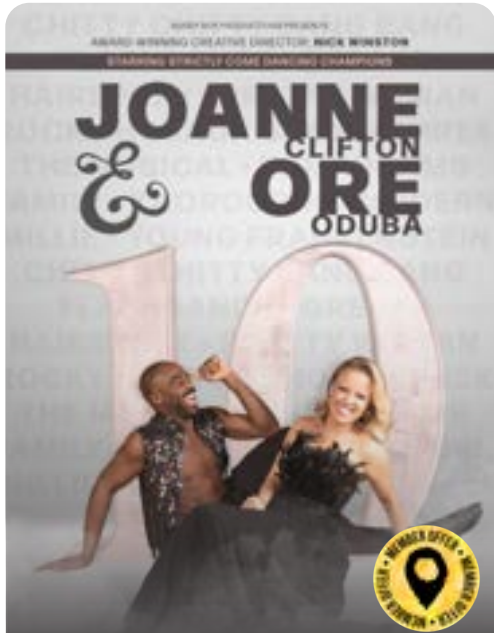
For some, this may be their first live magic show. For others, it is a rare chance to experience magic in a way that makes sense to them.
